



We are pleased to announce that the Board of Directors has approved **\$4,500.00** in Scholarships for the coming year. The **deadline to submit scholarship applications will be Monday, October 17, 2022**. Applications received/postmarked after that date <u>will not</u> be accepted. This scholarship award will be awarded January **10, 2023 at the GAPA General Meeting**.

**\$1,000.00** – "**Casper Lauer Scholarship**": Casper Lauer was the first Chicago Police Officer killed in the line of duty on 19 September 1854. This scholarship is donated by GAPA in his honor. (College / trade)

**\$1,000.00** – "Larry Vincent Scholarship": Larry Vincent was a Chicago Police Officer and GAPA member killed in the line of duty on 14 January 1983. This scholarship is donated by GAPA in his honor. (College / trade School)

**\$1,000.00** – **"Paul Bauer Scholarship"**: Paul Bauer was a Chicago Police Officer and GAPA member killed in the line of duty on 13 February 2018. This scholarship is donated by GAPA in his honor.

\$500.00 – "Glunz Family Scholarship": Donated by the Glunz Family. (College / Trade School)

\$500.00 – "Hofbräu Scholarship": Donated by the Hofbräu Beer Corporation. (College / Trade School)

**\$500.00** – "Presidential Scholarship": Donated by GAPA. (College / Trade School)

**\$TBA** – "Bill Ruck Memorial Scholarship": (College / Trade School)

#### Eligibility

The scholarship application process is open to all **immediate** family members of current active (dues paid) members attending any accredited college, trade school. Immediate family is defined as: sons, daughters, step-sons, step-daughters and those who are members of a family by court decree (legal guardianship). Only one application per eligible student will be accepted. Undergraduate **College** will be awarded one time to one person. All scholarship awards will be presented at GAPA'S **January** general membership meeting. Proof of enrollment / attendance is required for **all college** winners. Proof of attendance will be verified by the scholarship committee prior to the presentation of the scholarship awards.


